Classroom Expectations: The following norms and procedures are expected to be followed to ensure a safe and productive learning environment for all students. Students are expected to:

- Be ready to learn and in your seat when the bell rings. Office referral for tardies.
- Bring all required materials to class and take them when you leave. (Pencil, calculator, paper, notebooks)
- No use of any electronic device during class time. Even if your device has a calculator function. It has to be a **REAL** calculator with only math capabilities. I have the right to confiscate any device that is being used inappropriately.
- Respect yourself, myself, the others in class, and school property [room: smartboard, bulletins, other items on the walls, the walls themselves, and writing on desk (detentions)]
- Follow all rules and procedures listed in the CSHS Student Handbook.

Failure to meet the above expectations will result in the following disciplinary action:

First offense- verbal/written warning and documentation

Second offense- Office referral.

**Any student who physically harms or threatens another student or me will immediately be removed from the classroom and handled by school authorities.

**I reserve the right to skip steps listed above or remove a student from the classroom for severe behavior

**These expectations will be in effect at all times, even in the event that I am absent from the classroom.

Materials Needed for Class:

I have a very limited class set of a calculator. Students that rely on them, get disappointed when they come late to the test and everyone has already burrowed one.

Academic Honesty

All work should be a representation of your progress and achievement in this class. Cheating is not tolerated and will result in severe consequences; usually resulting in a zero for that assessment and possibly more. My trust is very hard to regain!

Attendance Policy: Making sure you are in class everyday is the most important thing you can do to be successful in this course. If you are absent, it is **your** responsibility to obtain notes (classmate or my website) **AND** do the corresponding homework.

Make-Up Work:

- If you have an excused absence, you have one day for everyday you were absent plus one to make up any missed work. If it is an unexcused absent and it is not turned in, you will receive a zero.
- It is your responsibility to find out the homework assignment and complete it, if you miss class. A good idea would be to check my website for the notes and homework/quiz so when you come back you will be ahead. If you need help we can schedule time or use my website appropriately for help (see help section).
- If you miss a test/quiz, make ups will not take place during the class period. Arrangements must be made to take a test/quiz before or after school or during your studyhall (if I have that time available). **Failures to show up for an appointment will result in an automatic zero for the test/quiz!**
- If you are only absent the day before an announced test, you will take the test as scheduled. Reviews are a privilege!
- If you are absent the day of an announced test or quiz, you are expected to take the assessment the day of your return. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- Any assignments/tests/quizzes not made up in the appropriate time will result in a zero.
- Be sure to check for your name on the board, reminding you that you messed a test so you can schedule a time to take it.

Getting Out of Your Seat:

There are several instances where you may want to get out of your seat during class. Please follow the procedures set in place for:

Sharpening a pencil – to be done at the beginning of class, but please ask and wait until class discussion is over

Throwing something away – keep whatever you wish to throw away at your seat, until you are dismissed from class

Using the Restroom – use the restroom between classes

- do not ask to use the restroom during class (the answer will be no) unless it is an extreme emergency
- if you are going to be sick, please excuse yourself from the room; I expect you are responsible enough to make the judgment

Dismissal: The bell is a signal for the teacher. I will dismiss you from class each day...do not excuse yourself. Do not start packing up before the bell rings. Wait until I finish and officially dismiss you. You may miss something important that would severely hurt your grade.

Make sure your work area is in the same or better condition than you found it!

Help: Questions are expected and encouraged during class time! Help is available outside of class by appointment (studyhalls, after, etc.). Every Friday, before school 7:00 – 7:30, will always be designated for help. There might be other days before school depending on that particular day. Be sure to find out!
